#### Art. 1.1 Preamble

#### Art. 4.1 Closing date for entries

# Art. 4.2 Entry procedure

Entries must be submitted in accordance with the FIA RRSR Art. 22 – Art. 25. See also FIA ISC Art. 3.8 – Art. 3.14

Entry is made only in electronic form at www.rallyekrumlov.cz.

An electronic entry application must be confirmed by way of personal signature by the competitor by the latest at administrative checks. The entry form must be accompanied by a copy of the valid competitor's licence. A change of competitor is permitted up to the close of entries. **Only the competitor entered in the event will be allowed to make this request**.

Foreign competitors, drivers and co-drivers must present authorisation from their ASN. (according to Art. 3.9.4 of the Code).

Applications will be confirmed by email.

An entry application (only made electronically) will be accepted only if accompanied by the total entry fees.

According to the International Sporting Code Art. 3.8.1 an entry compels the competitor to take part in the Competition in which they have been accepted to run, except in case of duly established Force Majeure.

All competitors taking part in a ERT event must ensure that their drivers and co-drivers sign the Driver's Declarations and Undertakings form as attached in RRSR Appendix XIV.

This form is available at <a href="https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/117">https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/117</a> (RELATED DOCUMENTS section). Please print, fill in and sign the Driver's Declaration.

The completed and signed Driver's Declaration must be handed to the organiser at the Administrative checks.

Crews holding international driver and co-driver and competitor licences with a car according FIA rules will be automatically included to the ERT classification. Other crews will drive in the national group and will be classified for the Czech Championship and RCH only.

#### Art. 4.3 Number of competitors accepted and vehicle classes

#### Art. 4.3.1 The number of competitors shall be limited to: 130

For the purpose of deciding the order of entries in relation to the maximum number of entries accepted, the only and decisive criterion is the date of payment of the full entry fee, with the understanding that FIA and ASN priority drivers will always be accepted.

# 4.3.3.4 Organiser's cup

Eligible cars: cars with national homologation (ASN homologation) or cars with valid or expired FIA homologation (FIA homologation since 1.1.1975), for which the company is not listed in the SR, can enter the Organiser's cup. Furthermore, vehicles of EU countries according to their national regulations (AMF, DMSB). Except for these, cars without national or FIA homologation are not allowed.

Obligation of the competitor for a car with foreign national homologation or for a car with FIA homologation modified according to the national regulations:

to provide the organiser with the national homologation of the car and the technical regulations according to which the car is to compete in the foreign championship at least 14 days before the entry deadline. Both documents will be immediately forwarded by the organiser to the Chief Scrutineer for verification. The Chief Scrutineer has the right to veto the approval of the application.

Any entry not accompanied by the entry fee shall be, according to Art. 3.9.3 of FIA International Sporting Code, null and void. The entry fee shall be paid by bank transfer to the account indicated below (in the latter case, adequate proof of payment must be attached to the entry form):

#### Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The deposit will be refunded in full:

- if the application is rejected,
- If the rally is cancelled,
- if the entry is cancelled before the deadline,
- for reasons of force majeure

#### Partial refund of the deposit:

- Crews who duly excuse their non-participation before the start of the reconnaissance will be refunded at least 80% of their deposit.
- Crews excusing themselves before the start of the administrative checks period will be refunded 50% of their deposit.

#### Art. 5. Insurance Cover

- Art. 5.1.1 The Autoklub of the Czech Republic has concluded with Allianz Insurance Company, a. s., through PLATINUM Consulting, s.r.o. an insurance contract No. C550012623 for insurance of the organiser's liability for damage caused to another in connection with the rally organiser up to the amount of CZK 50,000,000 (EUR 2 000 000).
- Art. 5.1.2 The framework insurance policy includes insurance of participants' vehicles against damage caused to third parties up to the amount of CZK 50,000,000 (EUR 2 000 000) per participant. The insurance does not cover damages caused by the participants to each other. The organiser undertakes to provide this insurance for all participants except for those who prove at the administrative check-in that they have taken out their own long-term insurance covering damage caused on the closed course.

Competitors and riders cannot be considered as a third party to each other.

- Art. 5.1.3 The insurance for organizers and participants is made with an integral excess of CZK 5 000 (EUR 200). It means that damage up to CZK 5 000 (EUR 200). won't be refunded and damage over CZK 5 000 (EUR 200). will be covered without the complicity of insured.
- Art. 5.1.4 All crews at administrative check have to hand in the valid International Green Card for their car. Without this card the crew won't be permitted to start.

#### 5.2 Insurance Coverage for the competitors and crews

All the drivers and co-drivers are obliged to arrange their own accident insurance. The proof should be documented on request at administrative check. The insurance of foreign crews have to cover the costs of possible medical treatment in the Czech Republic. Insurance cover must start from Free Practice / Shakedown until Parc fermé after the finish of the rally.

#### 5.3 Damage Reporting

The crews are obliged to notify the organizer about the damage caused on the track by their car by the end of event the latest. Violation of this duty stands for summoning the competitor and involved crew to a disciplinary committee.

# **5.4 Insurance Coverage Exclusions**

Auxiliary vehicles, cars dedicated to reconnaissance rides and vehicles with special labels issued by the organiser is not covered by the provided rally insurance (with the exception of insured organiser's cars) and those are always going on their own responsibility.

# Art. 7. Tyres

### Art. 7.1 Regulations regarding tyres which may be used during the rally

See Art. 13 of the FIA RRSR (tyres and wheels).

The hand cutting is permitted but must be in accordance with the patterns submitted by the tyre manufacturer to the FIA.

#### Art. 7.2 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

At all times during the event in the Czech Republic, the tread depth of the tyres fitted on the car, must not be less than 1.6 mm.

### Art. 7.3 National laws or special requirements

For Czech Rally Championship the tyres have to meet ACCR regulations 2025, see Art. 13. In Czech National Championship 2025 (cars in art. 4.3.3.1, 4.3.3.2 and 4.3.3.4 SR) tyres according to FIA 2015 - 2025 are allowed.

The hand cutting is permitted but must be in accordance with the patterns submitted by the tyre manufacturer to the FIA.

Barcode scanning will not be used for the Czech Rally Championship.

In Autoklub Czech Historic Sporting Rally Championship (cars in art 4.3.3.3 SR) tyres with EHK, DOT or FIA homologation can be used. Size has to be in comply with art. 8, appendix K of FIA International Sporting Code (tolerance maximum minus 3 %).

### Art. 8. Fuel

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (RRSR Art. 62). Unleaded fuel with maximum lead content of 0.013 g/l permitted.

#### Art. 8.4 Refuelling

**Art. 8.4.1** Refuelling is only allowed in Refuelling Area (RA) and commercial fuel station. To refuel in the service park is forbidden at any time.

**Art. 8.4.2** To access a Refuelling Area, all personnel involved in refuelling operations must wear clothing that provides adequate protection against fire and includes at least: long trousers, long-sleeved top, closed shoes, gloves and a balaclava.

Art. 8.4.3 Environmental Mat in a Refuelling Area (RA)

The organiser will protect the ground with an Environmental Mat.

#### Art. 9. Reconnaissance of Special Stages

Reconnaissance will be according to FIA RRSR Art. 35. The schedule for the reconnaissance is published in Appendix 2 of these supplementary regulations.

#### Art. 9.1 Registration procedure

Recce cars must be registered with a separate form.

Each car must be identified with a reconnaissance car number supplied by the organiser. Rally cars used in the event may not be used for reconnaissance.

During issuing of the road book each crew announces to the organiser the make and the plate of the car which the crew will use for reconnaissance. Changes must be reported to the phone + 420 724371037. The crew shall receive testing car plates and testing ride sheet to be returned on the administration takeover. Identification sticker must be affixed in right upper part of the windscreen and on the rear side windows until reconnaissance finish. This identification does not authorize the crew to entrance the service area. After reconnaissance finish, identification sticker must be removed.

# Art. 9.2 Specific regulations

During reconnaissance, all national traffic regulation must be followed, including but not limited to the speed limits. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organizer may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Speeding during reconnaissance will be penalised according to FIA RRSR Article 34.2.

- Art. 9.2.1 Reconnaissance programme is in Appendix No. 2. Crews must comply with FIA regional regulations and this SR about reconnaissance. Vehicles specified in art. 35.1 FIA regional regulations can only be used.
- Art. 9.2.2 According to 35.3 FIA regional regulations will not be accepted application of those who take reconnaissance between publishing of Supplementary regulations and closing date for entries. Crews who take reconnaissance after closing date for entries will be reported to the Stewards.
- Art. 9.2.3 After issuing of the supplementary regulations the person connected with crew can move on the rally track (with exception for walking) only with expressed agreement from the Clerk of the Course. Clerk of the course will not allow crew to start in the competition in case of branch of this regulation.
- Art. 9.2.4 Passing in opposite way is strictly prohibited with exceptions in the road book.
- Art. 9.2.5 Speed limits will be checked by organizer via GPS tracking system for reconnaissance. Failure to comply with the traffic regulations (especially speed limit) will checked and punished by Police of the Czech Republic in standard way. This doesn't preclude further sanctions on the part of organizer under according to FIA RRSR Article 34.2.
- Art. 9.2.6 The officials nominated by Clerk of the Course will check and make entries on the time cars at the start and finish, as the case may be on the route special stages. Their controls will be identified by means of standardised red signs for start and stop. The crew must stop at these controls, present their reconnaissance time card and follow the advice of control post chief. Officials nominated by the Clerk of the Course:

Art. 9.2.8 National or extra limits

The maximum speed on the roads is set by traffic laws. On selected roads, organizer approached on the basis of negotiations with the owners of communications and leadership of municipalities to set lower speed limits – during reconnaissance on SS 3/5 Kohout-Ján from SS START to village Velké Skaliny (forest road) - maximum speed is restricted to 50 km/h. A maximum 2 passes are allowed for SSS 1/9 České Budějovice and maximum speed is restricted to 50 km/h.

#### Art. 9.3 Number of Passages

The maximum number of passages authorised for each crew on each special stage is **three**. A maximum 2 passes are allowed for SSS 1/9 České Budějovice.

#### Art. 11.1.1 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

For each car of the **FIA Priority Drivers**, one spare gearbox and one set of spare differentials (front and/or centre and/or rear) may be used in each rally. These spare components and those fitted to the car will be

marked/sealed at initial scrutineering. These cars must have their sump guards removed for sealing of gearboxes and differentials and be kept with the car for the purpose of weighting.

The installation of the tracking system will be checked at scrutineering.

#### Art. 11.1.2 Timetable for scrutineering

#### Art. 11.2 Mud flaps

It is **optional** to fit transverse mud flaps in conformity with the article Appendix J, Art. 252.7.7

#### Art. 11.3 Windows

Use of tinted windows is not authorized in accordance with Article 253.11 "Windows/nets" of Appendix J of the FIA International Sporting Code.

# Art. 11.4 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

#### Art. 11.5 Noise level

All cars must be equipped with stable exhaust silencer. The outside noise level measured by stationary method may not exceed 96 dB/A for all cars with the margin of error plus 2 dB/A. The noise level will be measured at 3500 revs/min in petrol engine cars and at 2500 revs/min in diesel engine cars according to EHK Regulations 49.02.

Allowed noise level of historical cars for Czech rally competitions is 96 (A) + 2 dB (A) according to appendix K of International Sporting Code.

Noise level will be measured during scrutineering and eventually at any point during the rally. Any exceeding of noise limit during scrutineering results in start refusal, any exceeding of noise limit in the course of the rally will be reported to the Stewards.

#### Art. 11.6 Special national requirements

All vehicles according to Art. 4.3.2 SR have to comply with Czech law No. 56/2001 Sb. (Act on the Conditions of Vehicle Operation on Roads) with exceptions for sporting vehicles.

#### Art. 11.7 Installation of the safety tracking system Rally ONI system

Art. 11.7.1 All competitors must make provisions in their rally cars for the installation of the FIA Safety Emergency Console System, and the system must be installed before the car is brought to scrutineering. For installation and operating instructions see Appendix 6.

All rally participants will get their cars equipped with GPS monitoring devices:

ONI® monitoring devices ncluding two antennas, monitoring unit and red flag alarm diode.

Art. 11.7.2 After arrival to the scrutineering, device administrator will install the tracking unit, antenna and control panel to the vehicle prior to passing the scrutineering.

Art. 11.7.3 After the installation, the device administrator checks the mounting of the holder, installs the monitoring unit and tests the system using a "Dallas" chip. To install the GPS rental kit, it is necessary to prepare a 12V power outlet.

Eventual destruction, non-return or damage of the unit has to be paid for by the competitor to the provider in accordance with the applicable price list. Every attempt to falsify, manipulate or infringe the tracking device, which will make impossible to collect data because of external interference will be reported to the Stewards who can penalize the crew up to disqualification from the event.

# Art. 12. Other procedures and regulations

#### Art. 12.1 Ceremonial start procedures and order

There will be no Ceremonial Start.

### Art 12.1.1 Rally start - 1st section Leg 1

Crews will come with their cars by road book and in given time (in start order list) directly to start.

#### Art. 12.2 Start procedure on Special Stages (Electronic start procedure)

The electronic start procedure is as follows:

The start for SS will be performed by an electronic hand or digital countdown system clearly visible to the crew from the start position. The photocell is located at 50 cm behind the starting line at a height of 0.5 m (+5 cm).

The position of the vehicle at the start must be with the front of the vehicle on the level of the starting line. Timekeeper returns the time card in minute of start procedure.

Light signals combined with digital countdown system will be used:

40 seconds – red light switches on

30 seconds – the starter shows on starting countdown system

10 seconds – red light blinks on

START – green light switches on

-20 seconds - green light switches off and red light switches on and art. 48.4.3 of the FIA regional regulations will be applied.

#### Art. 12.3 Finish procedure [only if different from the Regulations]

#### **Art. 12.3.1** There will be a specific finish procedure.

Rally track finishes at entry TC to parking place before podium ramp. Podium will be prepared for first three crews in the general classification. Prizes described at art. 14 SR will be given during ceremonial prize giving. Crews must continue directly to parc fermé after finish ceremonial.

#### Art. 12.3.2 Availability of participants

Participants who park their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, must remain available by phone (mobile) until the final classification has been posted.

#### Art. 12.3.3 Classification

The final classification will be published on the Digital Notice Board

#### Art. 12.4 Permitted early check-in

Early entry to the TC 5A (Leg 1 finish) and TC 12A (rally finish) is permitted without penalty

# Art. 12.5 Super Special Stage, regulations, and order

There will be a Super Special Stage.

#### Super SS 1 / 9 České Budějovice Art. 12.5.1

In the TC, before the circular SS starts, the time that is the beginning of the driving period to the next TC is registered to the crews' time card. The timekeeper allows entering SS approximately in oneminute intervals regarding the safety of the drivers. Start of the stage will be flying, it means the crew starts to the special stage on green signal light (or other wave given by the start marshal) and the exact flying starting time will be recorded by the start detection device placed after the start line. The crew must complete the prescribed number of laps. After passing the flying finish of SS the crew is obligated to exit the circuit according to the Road Book instructions until reach STOP position, where it must stop. On this STOP control crews will not be informed about their reached time in stage.

#### Start using semaphore:

If the start will be done in expected starting interval (approx. 1 minute), timekeeper will show a table with number 5 approx. 5 seconds before green light appears on a semaphore. In case of longer delay than expected, timekeeper will show the table with a sign STOP and then show again the table with number 5 approx. 5 seconds before green light appears on the semaphore. Start at the red light is prohibited!

Art. 12.5.2 Any violation of these rules or shortening track will be reported to the Stewards.

Art. 12.5.3 The crew, who will not follow the prescribed number of laps, will be penalized 5 minutes per each lap which they do not take. If the number was exceeded, the real time covered all taken laps will be counted to the crew.

Art. 12.5.4 Crews who see red flag must immediately decrease speed and continue to the stop position no matter of passed laps. Notional time will be given.

### Art. 12.6 Special procedures and activities

#### Art. 12.6.1 Shakedown

Registration for shakedown should be confirmed in entry form and is charged with CZK 2 000 / EUR 83 for each car. Charge should be paid with entry fee. Registration is permitted up to the end of administrative checks. Participation on shakedown is only allowed to registered crews.

All security rules for SS are also valid for shakedown.

During Shakedown service is only permitted in the main service park.

In case of service park regulations breach, the Clerk of Course may penalise competitor by CZK 5 000 / EUR 208. Serious breach will be reported to the Stewards.


#### Art. 12.6.4 Chicanes (Barriers)

#### Art. 12.6.5 Tyre Fitting Area (TFA)

Each competitor will be allowed one (1) small vehicle (estate/van) with two (2) mechanics to assist the team. A handheld computer, a spare jack and four axle stands can be brought by a team member. Mechanics are also allowed to bring extra lights to TFA

A special service vehicle decal will be issued (one (1) per competitor number). These tire service vehicles may enter the facility up to 5 minutes before their rally car is expected to arrive and must leave immediately after the car leaves TC 3D!

One TFA vehicle may carry spare wheels for multiple rally cars, but must be marked for each competitor's entry number. Time movement in TFA applies.





# Appendix 5 – Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

# Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the FIA standards listed in Appendix L.

# Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

#### Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2000 standard (Technical List N°27) or to the FIA 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 <u>concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations Article 53.1.</u>

Any FIA-approved 8856-2018 garment customised using printing or transfers must be accompanied by a certificate from the manufacturer.

FIA Priority drivers (and accompanying co-drivers) must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2018 standard (Technical List No 74).

# Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

# Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of any type of jewellery, such as but not limited to, neck chains, bracelets or watches is prohibited during the competition. Exceptions to this rule, providing the CMO and/or Medical Delegate do not consider that due to size or location they may delay rescue or hinder emergency care, are:

- i. the wearing of watch(es) by co-drivers, on the condition that the watch(es) is worn over the overall,
- ii. the wearing of a single band-style ring providing it does not restrict the natural range of motion of the hand, and
- iii. the wearing of body piercing(s) providing they are not worn in and/or around the oral cavity.

The safety equipment of the crew, the safety equipment of the car and the minimum prescribed weight must comply with the valid technical regulations of the Czech Rally Championship (MČR), Rally Challenge (RCH) and Czech Rally Championship (Czech Rally Historic Sporting Rally) for vehicles belonging to a national group/class permitted by ASN without trophy points.

#### Driver safety equipment card

At the technical acceptance the competitor will hand over the details of the rider's and co-driver's safety equipment, the Card and safety equipment card is filled in via the IS of the Autoclub of the Czech Rpublic and the crew receives it upon acceptance the itinerary together with the technical card.

# Appendix 6 - Tracking system

# ONI® tracking system

# 1. General provisions

During the rally, all competition vehicles must be equipped with monitoring ONI® system. The ONI® monitoring equipment is the property of the Autoclub of the Czech Republic and the competitors must loaned to the competitors for a one-time fee of 160 CZK per unit (included in the entry deposit), or 530 CZK for the whole set (paid by the competitor), if he has not purchased the basic installation kit earlier. The price of the permanent installation set is 1320 CZK.

Any destruction, non-return or damage to the equipment must be paid by the competitor to the administrator according to the approved price list. Failure to return the unit immediately after the competition will result in the crew will be fined 3000 CZK. Until the unit is returned, the crew will not be allowed to start the next competition.

# 2. Distribution of the ONI® tracking system

ONI® tracking system contains following parts:

- tracking unit with display
- tracking unit holder
- power supply cable
- · combined antenna roof
- control panel containing:
  - OK button to cancel the alarm / confirm red flag
  - SOS switch for calling emergency

ONI® tracking system will be installed to every rally car before each event. Detailed information will be published no later than during roadbook issuing.

After arrival to the scrutineering, device administrator will install the tracking unit, antenna and control panel. Antenna and power supply cables can be purchased by the crew for personal ownership. At the end of the rally or after retirement, the tracking unit or complete tracking system must be returned to the device administrator The collection of units usually takes place in the service area before the rally finish, in front of the finish ramp or in a closed car park.

#### 3. Installation of the unit in the car

- **3.1** To fit the tracking unit with display, antenna and control panel, it is necessary for the competitor to follow exactly the Installation guide, to keep the unit in good condition and to protect it against damage and fouling (especially the connectors) during the time.
- **3.2** Foreign and one time rally participants will receive a rental version of the set equipped with magnetic roof antenna.
- **3.3** Control panel with OK button and SOS switch is in one box for which the competitor has to choose a suitable place for fitting within the reach of both crew members. It is obliged to prepare everything for its installation prior to the scrutineering.

#### 4. The unit operation during rally

To operate the unit, the crews have to meet all instructions as mentioned in the User's guide. Operation during events on SS:

# • Accident (crash detection)

- The unit evaluates the situation and sends info about accident to rally control. Crew cannot affect this message.
- The display shows message: Are you OK? Confirm.
- 10 s after this question, the siren wails for next 15 s



- If the crew pushes  $\mathbf{OK}$  button, this information is sent to rally control and information about accident is not sent to the unit of following cars in the stage.

#### Stop in SS

- When the car stops in SS, it is counted as an obstacle. Unit signals to the crew by sound siren and text, that they have stopped. This signal takes 15 s.
- If the crew doesn't push OK, warning message is sent to the rally control and also to other cars, which are currently in the stage arriving to the obstacle.
- With pushing the OK button the crew confirms that they are okay, on the display is shown message OK and information about obstacle is not send to the unit of next cars in the stage.

# Request for help

- Changing the switch is confirmed by SOS message on display, also the siren sounds.
- The siren sound can be cancelled by pushing OK button.

#### · Red flag

- When the rally control hangs out the red flag, the display shows big message RED FLAG (with red background) and the siren sounds.
  - Crew has obligation to confirm receiving the red flag by pushing the OK button and to reduce the speed according to the sporting regulations.
  - The siren sound can be cancelled by pushing OK button.
  - The red flag on display can be cancelled only by rally control.

# 5. Speed checking during reconnaissance

During reconnaissance the crew is obliged to follow traffic rules of the Czech Republic. Not respecting this rule, especially exceeding the speed limits, will be monitored via ONI® tracking system. This checking doesn't exclude other checks, i.e. police controls according to their standard procedures.

#### ONI® tracking system for reconnaissance

Tracking system is checking the speed in every moment during the reconnaissance.

Every crew will pick up the ONI® recce tracking unit together with roadbook. Installation of the unit and its using during reconnaissance is obligatory for all crews during the whole schedule of reconnaissance according to the art. 3 Reconnaissance schedule. For speed checking during the reconnaissance, NCL 21 units are used.



NCL21 unit is started during roadbook issuing before starting of reconnaissance. For whole reconnaissance the unit is working on its own battery. It is not necessary to plug the unit to any power supply.

It is possible to place the unit on metal surfaces - magnets are implemented in the unit.

Not using the unit in a rally car during reconnaissance will be fined.

Every attempt to falsify, manipulate or infringe the unit for reconnaissance or any device, which will make impossible to collect data because of external interference will be reported to the stewards who can penalize the crew up to refusing the start.

Decision regarding seriousness of the offence and its repeating is in Clerk of the Course's authority. For exceeding the speed limit, sanctions can be given according to supplementary regulations or championship regulations.
